Dates detailed above include Bank Holidays and School Inset Days

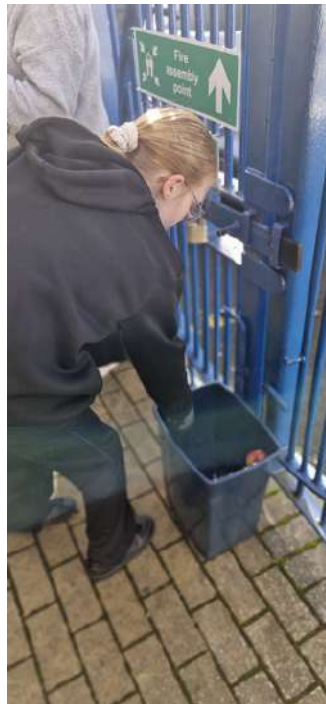
